# **Mobile Phone Policy**

#### Rationale

# **Content Organisation**

- Lessons will be taught at all class levels as part of S.P.H.E. programmes on the possible dangers of texting and bullying (Please see our AUP).
- If seen, phones and iPods will be confiscated and handed to Assistant Principal.
- These confiscated items must be collected by a parent from the principal.
- For health and safety reasons pupils are not permitted to use mobile phones, iPods or cameras during school tours and sporting activities.
