Ethos Matters:

Emergency Works:

- Emergency Works have been approved by the Department of Education and Skills to replace the existing ramp at 5th/6th and 3rd/4th class external doors. This will include the demolishing of the existing ramp and installing a new ramp which is fit for purpose, widening of the external doors and some yard resurfacing. Works are due to begin in early July.

Parents' Association

- The Board would like to sincerely thank the Parents' Association for all of their hard work and dedication this year. The partnership between the school and the Parents' Association allows for valuable enhancements to our school which enrich the children's experience.
- The latest PA Flag Day fundraiser raised a fantastic €2890. €1600 of this will go towards funding a new interactive whiteboard in the Infant classroom. There is a surplus of €1290 - uses for this surplus will be reviewed in September.
